## **Aims and scope**

The 34<sup>th</sup> International Symposium on Environmental Analytical Chemistry aims at bringing together scientists in the field of the research and development of analytical methodology for the determination of the elements, their species and organics as well as biomolecules in the environment, colleagues studying challenging questions regarding the impact of geogenic, anthropogenic, urban and industrial factors on the different compartments of the environment, instrument companies as developers and suppliers of the tools for environmental measurements in the broadest sense and colleagues from industry and regulatory bodies as well as organizations involved in environmental issues. Also the impact of factors relevant to the environment on the global climate will be treated and special attention will be given to questions of the marine environment. The symposium will include a number of invited lectures treating frontier topics of environmental analytical chemistry, such as:

- Miniaturized spectroscopic tools for environmental survey analyses
- Remote sensing in marine research
- Xenobiotics in natural waters,

as well as sessions with short lectures, poster sessions and an instrument exhibition.

It is intended to provide the possibility to publish the scientific contributions after peer reviewing in the Journal of Environmental Analytical Chemistry.

The best poster presented at the Conference will be honoured with the Roland Frei Poster Award.

## **Venue**

The symposium will take place at the Department of Chemistry of the University of Hamburg, where the lecture rooms, the exhibition area and the poster room are located closely together. The Chemistry buildings are located near to the city center and to the main railway stations of Hamburg (“Hauptbahnhof” and “Bahnhof Dammtor”) and with plenty of hotel accomodation in the nearest vicinity. The city has many places worth to visit, including the harbour area, the musea, the historic city hall, music performances and entertainment and is one of Germany’s most fascinating places to be.

The general assembly of the International Association for Environmental Analytical Chemistry will take place on June 5, 2006.

The Conference will also have a social programme including the opening reception, the conference dinner and a sight-seeing tour of Hamburg and its harbour.
